

Baker Hughes Health & Protection Benefits Enrollment Instructions

Enrolling in your Health & Protection benefits is simple, but if you have questions, these instructions can help.

1. Go to BakerHughesBenefits.com and click *Enroll, Review, or Change Benefits*. If you are accessing the site from the Baker Hughes Intranet, select *Health & Protection benefits – single sign-on from Baker Hughes intranet*. If you are accessing the site outside the Baker Hughes Intranet, select *Health & Protection benefits – access with login and password*. The first time you access the site, you'll have to register and authenticate that it's you. For your added security, the enrollment system requires multi-factor authentication, unless you go through the Baker Hughes Intranet.

Note: If you do not have an account on the enrollment system, you may need to create a User ID and password with at least 8 characters the first time you log in. If you go to the enrollment site through the Baker Hughes Intranet, you will not need to register.

2. Click *Get Started* when you're ready to enroll.
3. Review your personal and dependent information and make sure it's accurate. If you need to add or drop a dependent, this is where you'll make those changes.
4. There are three ways you can enroll when you're ready:
 - **Fast Lane** – it's designed for people whose enrollment decisions are simple, who know what they want, and/or are on the site to make a qualified status change (like getting married or having a baby).
 - **Shop on My Own** – it's designed for people who want to compare choices and costs, and who want to read more about their options.
 - **Get Recommendations** – it's designed for people who want even more help choosing benefits.
5. In *Your Cart*, you can make changes using the *Edit* or *Add* function on the left side. You can also see your cost per pay period on the right side. At the bottom of the page, you will see a summary of your total costs per pay period.
6. **Important:** Click on *Checkout* when you're done. If you don't click *Checkout*, your elections will not be saved.

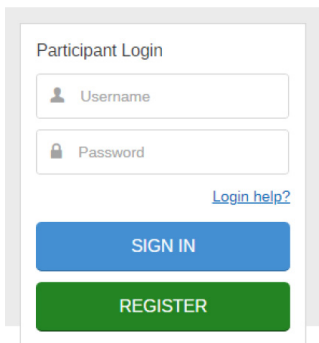

Accessing Your 401(k) Plan Account

1. Go to BakerHughesBenefits.com and click *Enroll, Review, or Change Benefits* . Then select *401(k) Account*.
2. Select REGISTER. The first time you access your new 401(k) account, you'll have to create your 401(k) user ID and password.

3. Create a username and password after providing required 5 data points (shown in image below) and entering a verification code sent to you by text or email. For your added security, the system requires multi-factor authentication. Depending upon your situation, additional verification steps may be required to authenticate your identity.

Accessing Your Legacy Baker Hughes Pension Plan

Go to BakerHughesBenefits.com/pension to access your Pension Plan account.

When you create an account, you will need to provide:

- The last four digits of your Social Security number,
- Last name, and
- Date of birth.

From there, you will create a user name and password, and set up your security questions. The new pension site uses multi-factor authentication to better protect your private data, so you will also need to confirm an email address or phone number for verification codes.
